

**Addendum to R. E. DARLING CO., INC. (“Buyer”)
Standard Terms and Conditions of Purchase
Conditions Applicable To Orders Placed Under
U.S. Government Programs For Commercial Items and Services**

If Buyer’s order is placed under a U.S. Government contract, or a **subcontract under any U.S. Government program for commercial items or services**, the following additional conditions are applicable:

The following provisions of the applicable Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and the DoD FAR Supplement (DFARS) [Title 48, U.S. Code of Federal Regulations] as of the date of this order, are incorporated by reference herein —

- (i) to the extent made applicable to Buyer’s order by the terms of each clause as written in the FAR and DFARS; or
- (ii) if the clause is included in the Buyer’s Prime Contract, it shall be of like effect as if fully set forth herein, except, that, whenever necessary to render a provision compatible with Buyer’s order the terms “Government” and “Contracting Officer” shall mean “Buyer”, Contractor” shall mean “Seller”, “Subcontractor” means “Seller’s subcontractors at any tier”, “Contract” shall mean “Buyer’s order”, and “Prime Contract” shall mean the Government program contract under which Buyer’s order is issued. Unless otherwise specified in the clause and in regulations applicable thereto, the applicable clauses shall be those in effect on the date of Buyer’s order.
